Fortem

Our partnership with Fortem

As a national social housing provider, Fortem have over 40 contracts across the UK providing housing maintenance and management. With a fleet over 5,000 vehicles they generate huge amounts of waste throughout the business. Through audits and numerous site visits and analysis we were able to implement a completely new process for them to dispose of their waste.

In the North West we kitted out a piece of land with a waste disposal facility solely for their use containing multiple skips,

ROROs and other hazardous waste containers (see below), this was a very central location for that project and was ideal for the team of 200 engineers to use daily. We coupled this with a direct tipping facility across the region, we partnered 25 waste transfer station and negotiated a very competitive rate for tipping (in most cases removing the minimum weight charge). We facilitated this by creating bespoke tipping permits.

This has been a very successful project and resulted in the business approaching us to do this with multiple other sites including their latest project-Birmingham.
